- Eligibility:**
- All children of the local community are welcome to play, regardless of religious faith.
 - Intramurals for Boys and Girls in grades 1 through 12
 - CYO Travel Programs for Boys and Girls grades 4-12
- League Structure:**
- The intramural program consists of 10 games plus **playoffs**.
 - For grades 1 and 2 the program is instructional with one weekly practice/scrimmage session.
 - Games are held on Saturdays for grades 1 through 4 and weeknights for grades 5 and up.
 - Intramural games begin in late November and end in March.
- Registration Period:**
- Intramural registration deadline 10/15/11. Late fee applies after 10/15.
 - CYO travel tryouts will be held in August/September. Eligibility is per CYO guidelines; see the St Matthew website for additional information. <http://www.smrcc.org/st-matthew-athletics/cyo-travel-basketball.org>. Players must be registered and have paid all fees to participate in travel tryouts.
 - Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis, and will be closed out when each grade level has reached capacity.
- Fees:**
- \$130 Intramural, \$90 for each additional child in family. Travel \$220 each child.
 - Late fee of \$20 for late registrants (after 10/15/11) and subject to availability.
 - Registration fees **do not** include uniforms. Intramural uniforms \$25, travel uniforms \$70.
 - Uniform sale dates to be announced. Uniforms from prior season may be re-used.
